
CleanMark does not intentionally add any of below materials during the manufacturing of its packaged products.

While analysis of below chemicals is not routinely performed on the final product, we do not expect these substances to be present.

- Heavy metals
- Phthalates
- Perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances

With main threshold limits defined as:

Lead (Pb)	Several control limits based on material type with max limit <800 ppm Or use applicable exemptions within RoHS regulation
Cadmium(Cd)	Several control limits based on material type with max limit <50 ppm
Hexavalent Chromium	Several control limits based on material type with max limit <500 ppm





Mercury (Hg)	<800 ppm
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)	<1000 ppm
Polibrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE)	<1000 ppm
Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	<900 ppm
Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP)	<900 ppm
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	<900 ppm
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	<900 ppm
